On another day, I was coming home from the University around 4:30 PM, when I hit an icy patch on the highway. I was going around 55 MPH and I lost complete control of the car. God's angels were there steering the car in such a way, that I didn't hit another car, pole, bridge, tree, etc. and the car didn't flip over.
