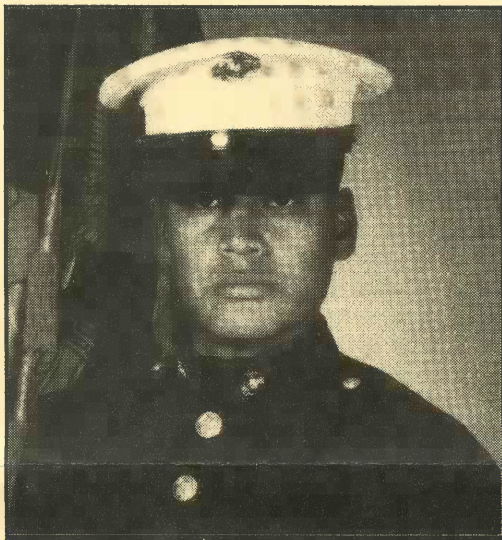


Stutzman Summary
