Forty Bible translators attended Verna's sessions on Lexicography - the art and science of making dictionaries.



Verna consulted with 13 different Wycliffe Bible translation teams, converting 17 language dictionaries and importing them into the LinguaLinks computer program.

In the National Translator Grammar course on Manus Island, Verna had 24 Papua New Guinea students who want to be involved in the Bible translation project into their own language.
