

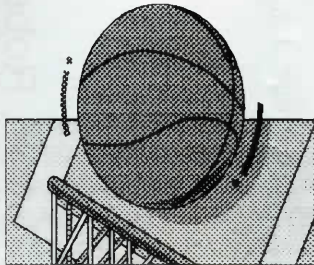
◆ Stutzman Summary ◆

Our Work

It seems that since we've discontinued work on the Lou translation project, we've been busier than ever helping other translation teams with their projects. (We've had no response from Lou Island about continuing the Lou project using Carla.)

Verna is setting up the Mauwake to Maia language adaptation using Carla (Computer Assisted Related Language Adaptation) for another team. In addition she is helping several other teams set up the language they're working on to be used in adapting scripture into other related languages. She enjoys this work immensely and calls Carla the 'ultimate computer game'.

Robert has gone to several villages to check translated scripture. Last month he went to Wanigela in Oro province to check II Corinthians for Duncan, a national translator who is translating for his own people. II Corinthians was Duncan's last book and the people were really happy when it was finished. They prepared a feast and gave Robert gifts to show their appreciation for his help.

Thanks for praying for us. Instead of feeling sad about leaving PNG without completing a New Testament ourselves, we're feeling excited about helping other teams with their translation projects. We've had a lot of experience, so we are qualified to help other translators.

Our Future

Robert has been invited to work in both the Finance and the Translation departments at the International Headquarters for Wycliffe in Dallas. He is waiting until we get to Dallas to finalize exactly what his responsibilities will be.

Verna has been invited to program the LinguaLinks for Carla and to train as an International Carla consultant.

We will be leaving PNG on June 23/95. Jeremy is flying straight through to Canada. Robert and I are spending a week in Australia visiting friends and then a week in Dallas visiting Jason and making living and working arrangements for returning to Dallas. After seeing Jason we will travel to Manitoba, where we will visit supporting churches and friends. We will then rent a U-haul and move our possessions to Dallas arriving there around Aug. 10th.
